

MAKING YOUR CHAPTER 13 PLAN PAYMENTS

Your first payment is due no later than thirty (30) days after your case is filed.

If you wish to stay in Chapter 13 you must make a plan payment each month or the Chapter 13 Trustee will Motion to dismiss your case.

You have 3 payments methods available to you:

1. Wage Deduction

This is the method preferred by the Court. Your employer will be required withhold the plan payment from your pay check and at least once per month send the funds to the Trustee. Most employers will split your payments into weekly or bi-weekly deductions.

2. ACH Bank Debit

You may authorize the Trustee to debit your plan payments from a checking or savings account. Payments can be deducted once or twice per month.
